Prayer for the 238 Men Deported to El Salvador

To the God who can do more than we could ever think or imagine, please bring them home. You're the God who freed Israel from their enslavement. Please bring them home to their families. I pray, peace and comfort for their families. Over their parents, partners, children, and friends.

I ask that Justice be done. You are God and nothing is beyond You. Nothing is too great or too hard for You. Jesus, You came to set the prisoners free and break the chains of the oppressed.

Holy Spirit, show me how to pray for these men and all those unjustly imprisoned, forcefully deported and those still in the U.S. who are living in fear of their protected status being revoked or ignored. All those who fear being taken from their lives and their families.
